ACDH-CH

- Founded 2015, concepts since 2013
 - on the backdrop of the research infrastructures
 CLARIN and DARIAH part of the DNA since conception
- Mission: "fostering the use of digital methods and tools in the humanities research in Austria" by
 - building up digital infrastructures
 - developing technical tools and services
 - hosting and publishing digital data
 - intensifying knowledge transfer



ACDH-CH - structure

- Rapid growth (from 12 in 2015 to 130 in 2022)
 - => series of reorganisations
- ~80 projects running at the moment
- Since 2020 + "Cultural Heritage"
- As of 2023 five research units:
 - Linguistics
 - Literature and Text
 - Biographies
 - Musicology
 - DHRI Digital Humanities Research & Infrastructure




Repository Landscape

Research Infrastructures What are they (good for)?

"facilities that provide resources and services for research communities to conduct research and foster innovation." [EC]

- No humans mentioned => Networks of people / expertise
- complex relationship (bottom-up, top-down)
 - Fostering exchange and knowledge sharing
 - Consolidation, harmonization (standards, best practices)
 - Community representation in ERA-context
 - Provision of services
- Broker/Hub, Mothership
